The Study

The Town of Richmond Hill is undertaking an update to its 2006 Transportation Master Plan. In the fall of 2006 the Council of the Town of Richmond Hill endorsed the recommendations of the Transportation Master Plan (TMP), which recommended a Sustainable Multi-Modal Network to accommodate travel demand for the following 15 to 20 years. Building on the transportation vision and strategy that was developed in the 2006 TMP, this study will update the 2006 recommendations to support growth in Richmond Hill to 2031 as well as accommodate provincial and regional planning goals. The TMP Update is a part of the overall Official Plan review process and will provide the basis for revisions and input to the transportation components of the Town's Official Plan.

The Process

This study is a technical update to the 2006 TMP document and meets the requirements of Phases 1 and 2 of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) process (MEA, October 2000 as amended in 2007) which is an approved process under the Environmental Assessment Act.

Public Consultation

Public consultation is vital to this study and the Town of Richmond Hill appreciates your input and ideas. This Public Information Centre builds upon discussions and input received in May 2009 during the Transportation Forum and OP Summit and will present the preliminary updated transportation findings and recommendations. This PIC is intended to facilitate discussion and solicit feedback for the final updated 2010 TMP Report.
